

## Gingerbread Icing Fingerless Gloves 1of 2

This pattern knits up quick to create chunky fingerless gloves that coordinate with the other Gingerbread Icing Patterns.

Needles: US 7 ( 4.5 mm )
double pointed needles
Yarn: Approximately 100 yds Worsted weight or slightly heavier works fine.

Gauge: 5 stitches +6 rows $=1$ inch in stockinette stitch.

## Abbreviations:

st: stitch
cn: cable needle
k: knit stitch
p: purl stitch
p2 tog: purl two stitches together at the same time
p1 f\&b: purl into the front and back of the stitch to increase by 1 stitch
2/2 LC: place 2 st on cn and hold in front, k2, place 2 st from cn onto left hand needle and k2.

## Start

Cast on 36 stitches. Place 10 st on first needle, 15 st on second needle, and 11 st on third needle.

ROW 1: Move last st on third needle next to the first st on the first needle and p2 tog to join row. [k4, p1] 6 times, k4.
(35 st total)
Row 2: [p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k1]
3 times, p1, k4.
Row 3: [p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k4]
3 times, p1, 2/2 LC.

## PATTERN REPEAT ROWS

(See chart on next page)
Row 4: [p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k1]
3 times, pl, k4.
ROW 5: [p1, k4] 7 times.
Row 6: [p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k1]
3 times, pl, k4.
ROW 7: [p1, k4] 7 times.
Row 8: [p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k1]
3 times, p1, k4.
Row 9: [p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k4]
3 times, p1, 2/2 LC.
Rows 10-15: Repeat rows 4-9.
Rows 16-21: Repeat rows 4-9.
For a longer cuff, repeat rows 4-9 one or two more times.

## Start Thumb Gusset

(Gusset sts are in italic)
Row 22: p1 f\&b, [k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4. (36 st total) Row 23: p , [k4, p1] 6 times, k 4 . (36 st total)
Row 24: pl f\&b twice, [k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4. (38 st total)
Row 25: pl, k2, p1, [k4, p1]
6 times, k4. (38 st total)
Row 26: $p 1$ f\&b, $p 2, p 1$ \&\&b,
[k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4. (40 st total)
Row 27: p1, k4, p1, [2/2 LC, p1, k4, pl] 3 times, 2/2 LC.
(40 st total)
Row 28: pl f\&b, kl, p2, k1, pl f\&b,
[k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4.
(42 st total)
Row 29: p2, k4, p2 [k4, p1] 6 times, k4. (42 st total)

ROW 30: p1 f\&b, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1, pl f\&b, [k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4. (44 st total)
Row 31: p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, [k4, p1] 6 times, k4. (44 st total) Row 32: p1 f\&b, k1, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1 f\&b, [k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4. (46 st total)
End increases, gusset should have 12 stitches for a total of 46 st per round.

ROW 33: p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k2 p1,
[2/2 LC, p1, k4, p1] 3 times, 2/2 LC.
Row 34: p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, [k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4.
ROW 35: p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k2, p1, [k4, p1] 6 times, k 4 .
RoW 36: Place first 12 st on a piece of waste yarn to hold them (they will be worked later to complete the thumb) and cast on 1 st to start first row, then continue in pattern [k4, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times, k4. You should have 35 st on the needles again.

## Continue Glove

Row 37: [p1, k4] 7 times.
ROW 38: [p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k1] 3 times, p1, k4.
Row 39: [p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k4] 3 times, p1, 2/2 LC.
Rows 40-45: repeat rows 4-9
Rows 46-51: repeat rows 4-9
ROW 52: [p1, k4, p1, k1, p2, k1] 3 times, pl, k4.
Row 53: bind off in pattern.

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## Finish Thumb:

Place the 12 st on 2 needles to start. Row 1: Pick up 1 st to the right of first the thumb st and $k$ into it, p2, k1, p1 for first needle. Second needle, k1, p2, k1, p1. Third needle, k1, p2, pick up 2 more st in back of thumb and kl, pl to complete row.
ROW 2: [k4, pl] 3 times.
Row 3: [k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times.
Row 4: [k4, pl] 3 times.
Row 5: [k1, p2, k1, p1] 3 times.
Row 6: [k4, pl] 3 times.
Row 7: bind off in pattern (row 5).

Complete second glove same as the first, the pattern is same on palm and top of glove.
